Security Guard Certificate Training is a 1-week course delivered at Quetico Conference Centre with the instruction required to complete the Ontario security guard exam. Those that pass the exam at the end of the course will earn the Ontario Security Guard Agent License and can work as a security guard at the camps and material yards used to build the Wataynikaneyap Power Transmission Line Project. The skills and certificates are transferable to security guard employment opportunities throughout Ontario. The course includes CPR and First Aid certificates and instruction in health and safety, emergency response preparation, the Canadian legal system and effective communications. Travel, accommodation and meal allowance are included.
