ENTRY "BUBBLE"



You may have questions or concerns surrounding COVID-19 and what steps are being taken by Valard and Wataynikaneyap Power to mitigate any spread of the COVID-19 virus. Each project camp location has their own "bubble" and below are the steps taken to getting employees safely to work in the bubble.



When workers arrive at the project, they meet the medic in full PPE. The medic obtains a nasal swab along with completing the written COVID-19 questionnaire.

The worker is then isolated with no interaction with anyone else already inside the "bubble".



The results from the nasal swab that is analyzed by the approved rapid test (PCR System), are typically available in approximately 2 hours. Once the worker receives a negative test, they are then allowed to enter the "bubble" and interact with other workers while still maintaining Public Health guidelines (i.e., Physical distancing, face coverings, hand sanitizing etc.,)
