NorthWinds Environmental Services

Giiwedin Environmental Services is completing the Permanent Wildlife Survey Plot (PWSP) monitoring program for the Wataynikaneyap Power Transmission Line Project. The PWSP program is in support of the project's Endangered Species Act, primarily associated with woodland caribou and wolverine. Giiwedin field staff have successfully established 50 survey plots and are in the second year of field data collection for this long-term monitoring program. In coming years, more plots will be established along the transmission line. The survey program includes looking for wildlife tracks and activity, site condition information, human activity, and changes to each site over time. Monitoring of changes in wildlife access and use will be ongoing over the next 10+ years.
